The following is taken from *Laws of Duplicate Bridge Through the Eyes of the Player* by Larry R. Harris

ACBL Policy – “This Player is interfering with my enjoyment of the game.” (74A2)

Zero Tolerance – Unacceptable Behavior

1. Negative comments regarding partner’s or opponents’ play or bidding.
2. Badgering, rudeness, insinuations, threats, intimidation, profanity or violence.
3. Constant gratuitous lessons and analyses at the table.
4. Gloating over good results.
5. Loud and disruptive arguing with a director’s ruling.

Do not become guilty of any of the above infractions. Commonly referred to as ZT, it is not tolerated by the ACBL. If encountered, two alternatives are available to the Director, both of them bad.

First Offense: A procedural penalty of one quarter board or 3 IMPs. The procedural penalty can be additive. If both members of a partnership are guilty of a ZT violation, the penalty is doubled, to one half of a board.

Second offense: Ejection from the game.

Should an opponent(s) engage in one or more of the above behaviors, don’t hesitate .. **Blow the whistle!**
