#### COURTESY & ETHICS

*(This write up is courtesy of a Cleveland Director. There are seven more points that will appear next month. All are worth looking over but more importantly put into practice.)*

1. When any player removes their hand out of the slot, it is time for **conversation to cease and bidding to begin.**
2. When you are thinking about making a bid, do not "hover" or finger your bidding box. This is "informational", especially if you wind up passing and can result in penalties.
3. **When auction is over and you are on lead, please LEAD FIRST,** then write the contract in your

scorecard. This allows dummy to be faced and declarer and your partner to contemplate their line of play. When you write in your scorecard before leading it delays the game and isn't fair to declarer or partner.

4. Rehashing or discussing the hand you just completed is frowned upon and causes delay of game. Can result in late play or indemnity (matchpoints being subtracted from your score). Most directors only permit one late play—if any.
5. Comparing results or discussing hands with other players during the session is not ethical and can lead to the director penalizing you for doing so.
6. Don't talk about what your opponent did that helped you make a contract or an overtrick while the opponent is still at your table. There is nothing worse than for them to hear you say something like: well, if he/she hadn't done (whatever) I could not have made (whatever). Sure makes opponent feel stupid and that carries over to the next table where they will probably give away another board because they are thinking about how "dumb" they were on the last one.
