#### COURTESY & ETHICS

*(This write up is courtesy of a Cleveland Director. Here are the seven points that did not fit last month. Put into practice.)*

1. Be friendly to the people who come to your table, or to whose table you arrive. Compliment your partner or opponent when they make a good play or bid. Keep quiet when they "screw" up. Save your discussion for when you are in between rounds.
2. **Bridge is a timed event.** Your fair share of time on each hand is 6 to 7 minutes, max! Don't hog the time

- by tanking over your bids and plays and rehashing between hands.
3. Please don't "snap" your cards when playing. This is annoying, distracting and rude. (besides, it ruins the decks.) and can result in a "director call".
4. If defending, do not detach a card from your hand until it is your turn to play. This is "informational" conveying info to partner before they play. Very unethical!
5. Always remember: **Your partner had a reason for what they did**—right or wrong. Respect that!!! Ask their reasoning so that you are on "the same page".
6. **If there is a problem, the director should be called.** Some experienced players "make their own ruling without doing so. Example: *insufficient bids*. There are many choices besides making it sufficient that you need to be aware of. *Hesitations*: The director should be called to protect the auction. Just because partner hesitated does not bar you from bidding. There are many more examples, too numerous to list here.
7. When you call the director, say "**Director, please**". This is much less scary than a loud "DIRECTORRRRR!!!" and much more friendly! When the director arrives at the table, only one person should explain the problem. The director is there to help you, not punish you!
