Fall 2011 Team League – There is still time to participate in the **Team** event starting this month You can sign your Team up for the four night 2011 Fall event which will be held **September 16, October 21, November 11, and December 16**. This TEAM LEAGUE event, however, will use the “**Eight is Enough**” format. Teams must be made up so the team total is no more than eight points; where A players (1500 or more master points) are 3 points, B players (500 to 1500 master points) are 2 points, and C players (0 to 500 master points) are 1 point. Teams will be placed in brackets based on the ACBL masterpoints of the four highest team members. All matches will be handicapped based on the player used for each match. The handicap for each match will be assigned based upon the ACBL published team

handicap table.

Autumn Sectional - The Autumn Sectional will be held on September 30, October 1 & 2 at the Quirk Center in Cuyahoga Falls. Stratification for all Events will be determined by player average Master Points. Stratified Open Pairs and Stratified 499ers Pairs games will be held at both sessions on Friday, and Saturday. This Sectional will feature a three-session Bracketed Handicap KO Team event, with the first session at 7:00 p.m. on Friday and the final two sessions on Saturday.
